I am directed to convey the sanction of President of India to the payment of Grants-in-aid amounting to Rs. 10,80,00,000 (Rupees Ten Crore Eighty lakh only) to the State Government of Punjab as Central Assistance for the following SPMRM clusters:

2. **The next release will be made on fulfillment of the following conditions:-**

- (i) Preparation of DPR for all CGF components.
- (ii) Commencement and completion of all soft components for which DPR preparation is not required, such as training modules for all skill development activities, purchase of equipment, procurement of cabling lines etc. -such components would be identified for each cluster in consultation with the Ministry.
- (iii) Setting up of the State Project Management Unit-SPMU with at least 3 professionals as per qualification criteria mentioned in Framework of Implementation.
- (iv) Setting up of the District Project Management Unit and/or Cluster Development Management Units as decided by the State with each unit manned by at least 2 professionals as per qualification criteria mentioned in Framework of Implementation.
- (v) Initiation of the Master Planning process for each cluster in consultation with the town planning department of each State.
